Vision Statement - Our Vision of Success

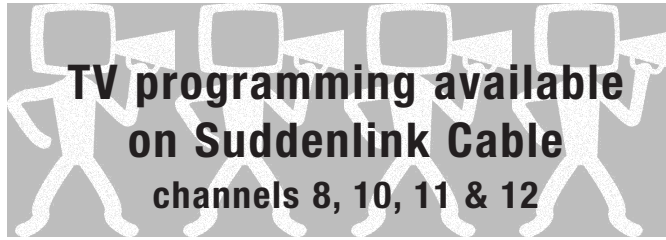
Access Humboldt is an innovative, self-sustaining and trusted media resource for residents of Humboldt County.

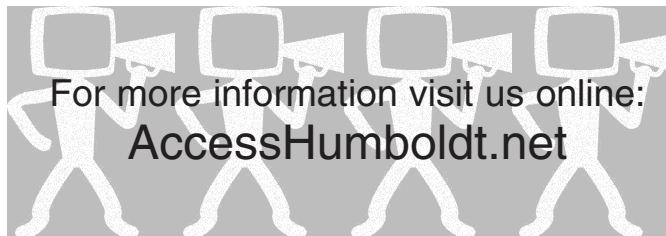
